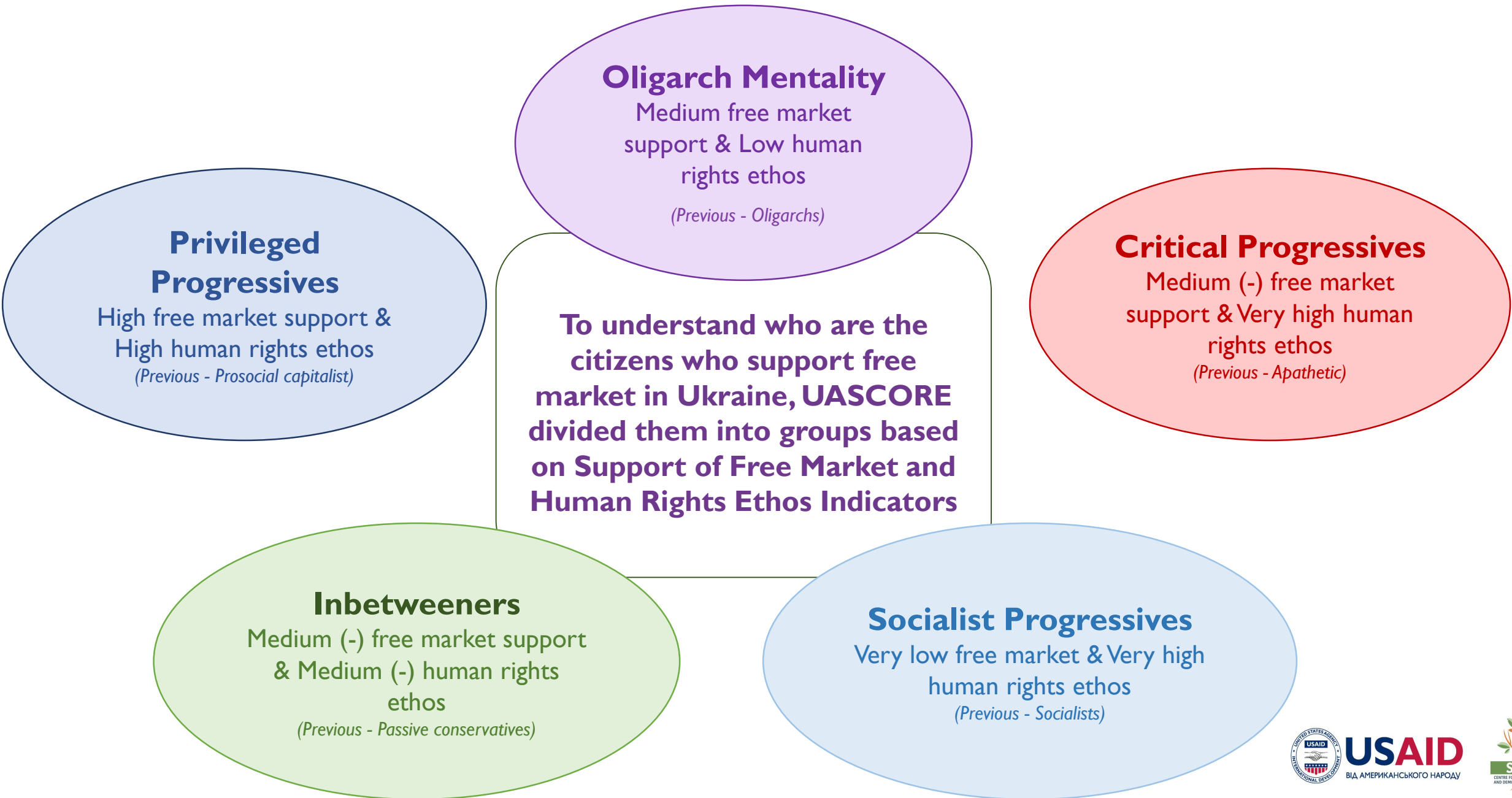

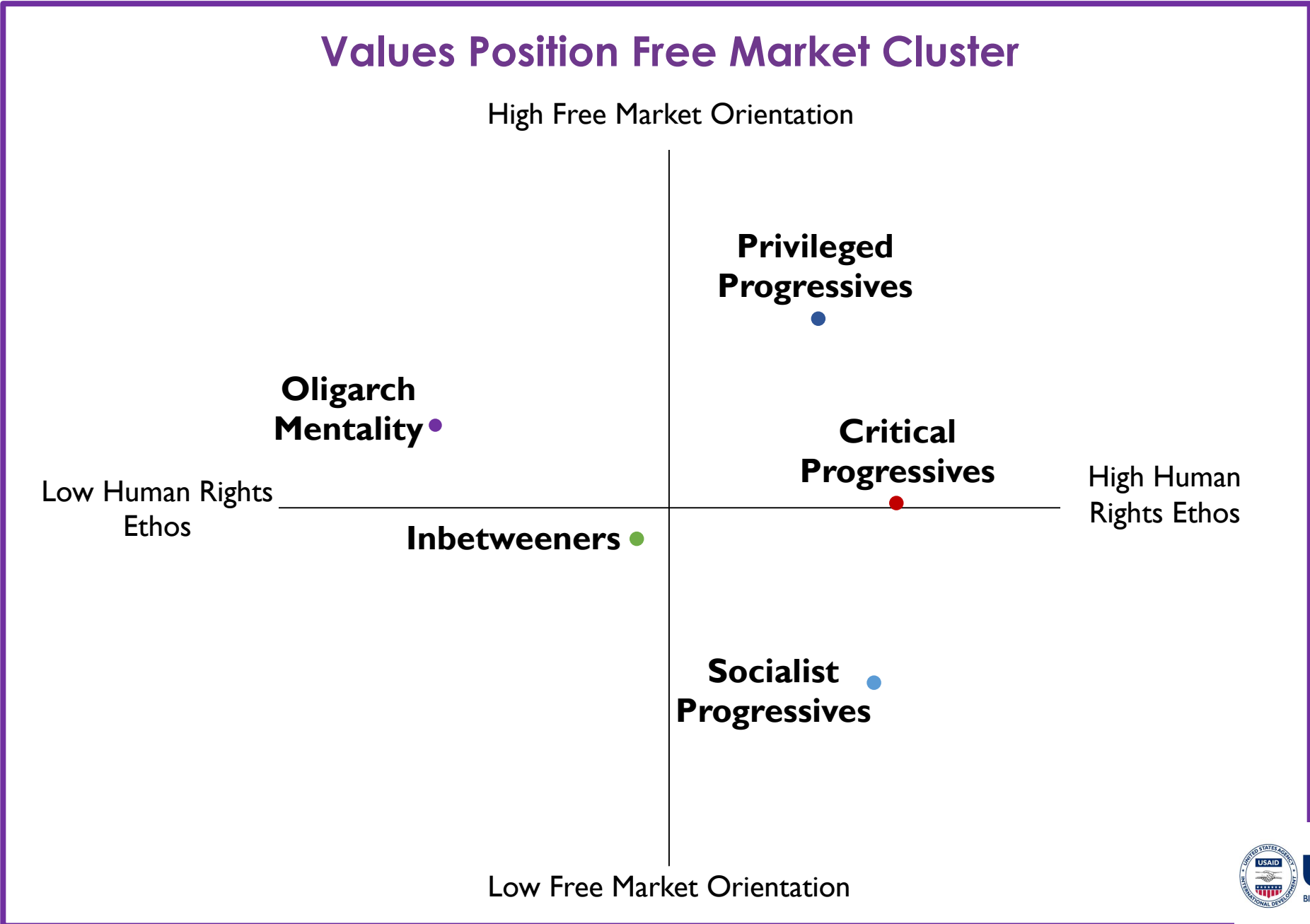

Privileged Progressives

9.87%

- Share human rights ethos, good social skill and support EU orientation.
- They have highest of all groups income and support free market the most.
- This group trust all institutions and community, have nationalistic sentiment.

Oligarch Mentality

10.37%

- Have weak human rights ethos and low civic responsibility.
- This group trusts authorities but not the community, tolerate corruption and do not perceive the EU as beneficial for Ukraine.
- They support separation of Donbas, do not share pluralist identity and is psychologically distressed.
- This group has a good income, positive perception of economic opportunities and support free market

Critical Progressives

39%

- Are the most tolerant, pluralist and civically responsible with the strongest human rights ethos.
- They are critical of national institutions and reform implementation.
- They trust community, support reintegration of Donbas and boast good social skills and psychological wellbeing.
- This group has a good income and medium free market support.

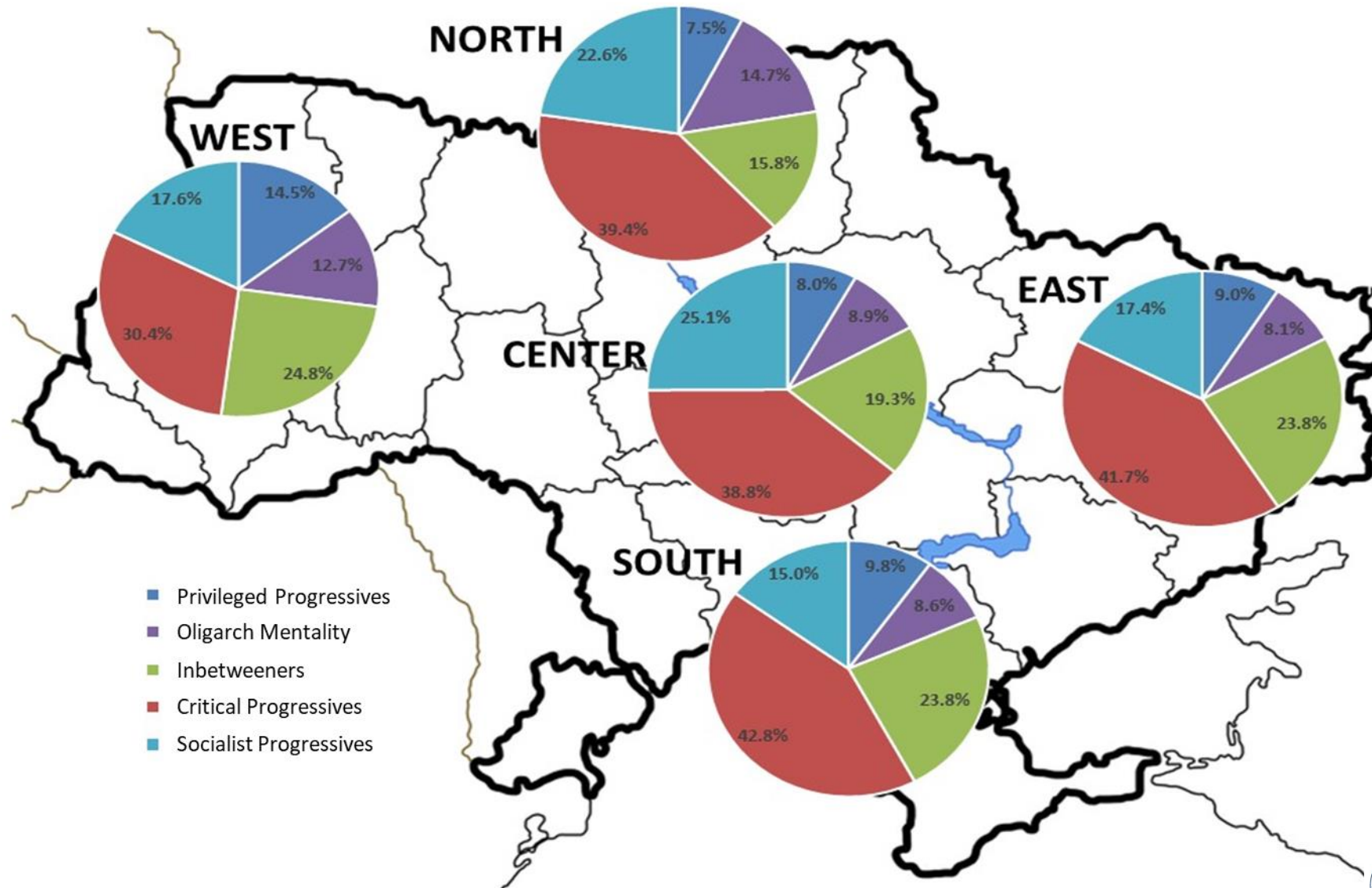
Socialist Progressives

18.8%

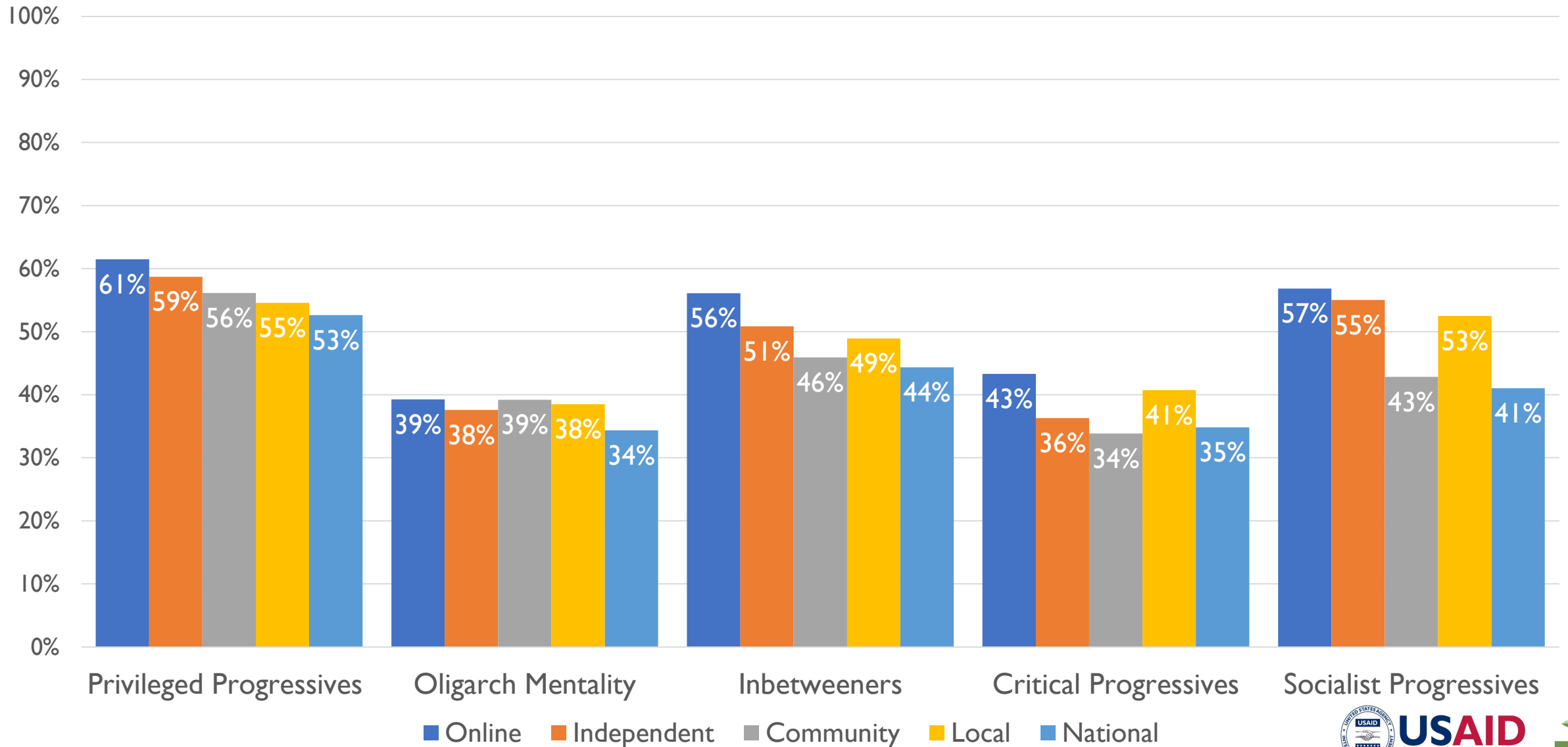
- Have strong human rights ethos, are tolerant and civically responsible.
